INTRODUCTIONS TO DATA SETS

(Before the stand alone set)

The following file includes base survey data, as well as data drawn from survey questions developed specifically for the study in Lima.

In Lima, the LAHN survey was directed solely at lot owners (see lot selection procedure). The lack of renter surveys is unfortunate as recent research suggests that renting is and will likely continue to be an important phenomenon in Lima (Rojas forthcoming M.A/M.S. Thesis, expected graduation December 2012). Researchers did, however, add several questions about renting to the owner-focused surveys (e.g. type of rented space, the rental cost, and familial ties between landlord and tenant.) The Lima surveys also included questions about vertical property rights or *los aires* (use and ownership), various public spaces (state, maintenance, usage limitations), and security (specifically the presence and motivation for gated residential streets).
