In such a case, the second contract would be counted as an outstanding contract for deed, if not subsequently cancelled, were it to have been drawn in our 10 percent sampling. Those contracts found to have been assigned by the buyer were deemed to be outstanding, as they were viewed as a perpetuation of the decision-making of the original parties.



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


Figure 3.1 Recorded Contracts for Deed by County 1989-2010




3 Year Running Averages Total CFD






Transaction Usage Rate Graph




Housing Unit Usage Rate Graph
